



PracticePlanet After/Before School Program or Homework

Students attend an After/Before School Program for a variety of reasons, but one of the goals can be to provide students with remediation for unmastered math and language skills. Because After/Before School Programs often include a mix of grade levels and subjects, PracticePlanet is an excellent solution.

- PracticePlanet provides assessments and practice to help prepare students for a state specific assessment and achieve standards proficiency.
- Because PracticePlanet is online, students have access to the activities by logging on to the Internet from school, home or the library.
- PracticePlanet has content for grades 2-9 for math and language arts.
- PracticePlanet will automatically assign appropriate practice based on pretest results.
- Students are rewarded with a variety of games as they master skills.
- Students can access their Test Summary at any time. This report can be shared with their parents or guardian from the student's home and may be used to track their successes.
- Teachers can set up classes, make or change assignments, and work with students from home or school.

Sample After/Before School Program or Homework Plan

The number of questions on each assessment and skills assigned will vary depending on a specific state's testing or curriculum standards.

The following is based on a semester program with an estimated 30 language arts skills and 20 math skills assigned by each grade-level pretest. This assumes students will have 90 minutes of computer time a week.

This is a suggested program and can be adjusted as needed based upon your program and student rate of progress or needs.

Teacher:

1. Set up classes and students – refer to Quick Start document.
2. Assign assessment based on previous grade for first (fall) semester.
3. Assign assessment based on current grade for second (winter) semester.
4. Review Class and Student Reports every week!
5. Use preferences to adjust game frequency to every 3 correct answers and mastery percentage.
6. Upon the completion of the posttest, reassign pretest based on the current grade level.
